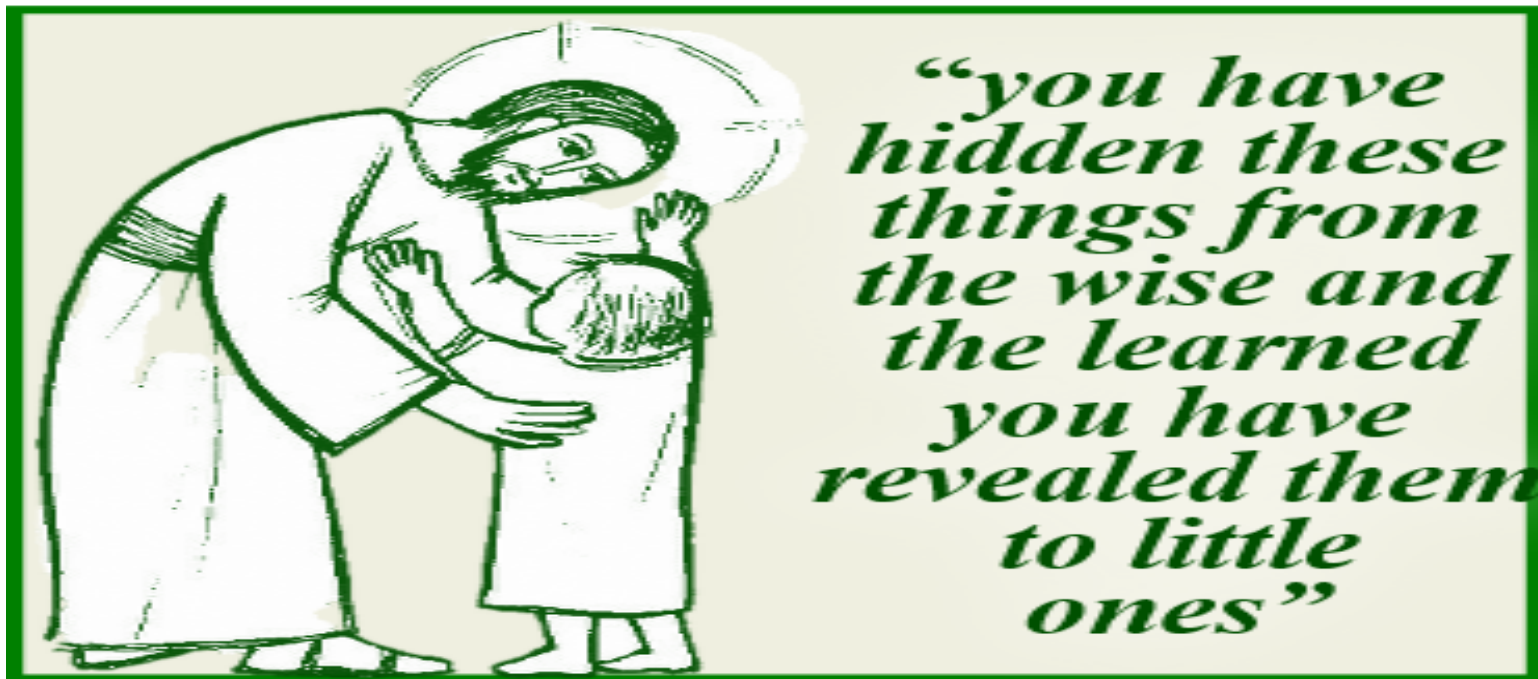

14th Sunday in ordinary time cycle A

The Sacred Heart of Jesus is called a “devotion” because it gets us on fire more quickly for God. The Sacred Heart is like one of those firefighters some folks throw on the barbecue to get it going. (I know everyone has their own way of firing up the grill — just bear with me!) The heart is an image everyone can understand: by focusing our minds and our imaginations on the Heart of Jesus, meek and humble, on fire for us all and for his heavenly Father, we can rekindle our faith, our hope, and our love. And by some wonderful grace, we will find that we are also more able to find true rest.

Jesus knows how tired we sometimes are. He Himself sometimes was exhausted. He gets us. That is why he invites us to come and unburden ourselves on Him: “Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest.” You don’t have to have some fancy college degree to get how good the Lord is with us: in fact, Jesus praises his Father for the exact opposite thing. “I give praise to you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, for although you have hidden these things from the wise and the learned you have revealed them to little ones.”

So, as we take some time off this summer, let us entrust all our worries and concerns to Our Lord. Let us bring all that to the fire in Christ’s Heart. Let Christ both burn away our waste and fill us with good food for body and soul. Let His Sacred Heart give us rest. In the beautiful words of the response to this Sunday’s psalm: “I will praise your name for ever, my king and my God.” Praising the Sacred Heart of Jesus and His most Holy Name makes us truly happy and gives us true rest.
