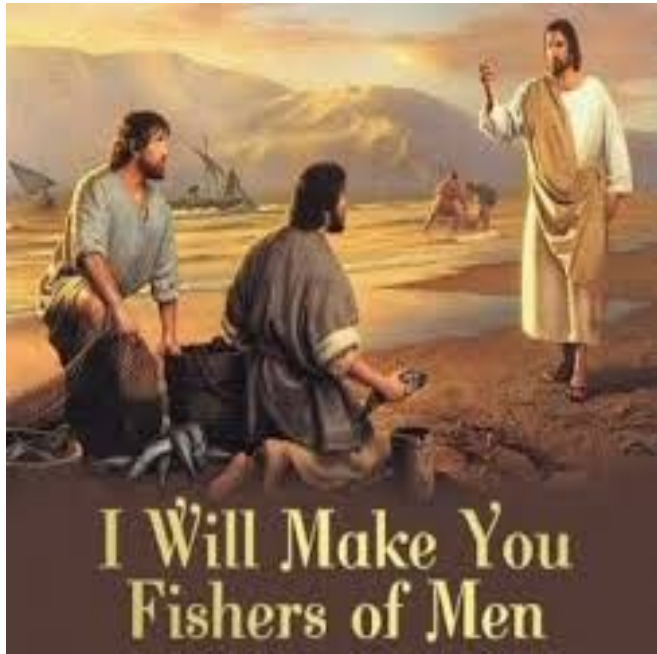

Saint Thomas Aquinas Priest and Doctor of the Church

He is considered the Dominican Order's greatest glory. He taught philosophy and theology with such genius that he is considered one of the leading Christian thinkers. St. Thomas ranks among the greatest writers and theologians of all time. His most important work, the Summa Theologiae, an explanation and summary of the entire body of Catholic teaching, has been standard for centuries, even to our own day. At the Council of Trent it was consulted after the Bible. (1225-1274)

Light For The World

In today's Gospel Matthew applies to Jesus the prophetic oracle of Isaiah: "The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light; upon those who dwelt in the land of gloom a light has shone." In like manner, the psalmist's assertion that the Lord is my light is echoed in Jesus' words: "I am the light of the world; the man who follows me will have the light of life."

Christianity is about truth and light. Just as Jesus is light to the world, so his church is to be light and truth in a world of darkness. Light of Christ enables the beauty of things to be seen, and we are called to make the message of Christ change our world. But we are not to call attention to ourselves: if you are aware of the light in a room, it is too bright. Our vocation is for others, not ourselves.

Surrounded by discrimination, oppression and war, Christians are challenged to "be united in faith and humility," and they are directed by God's love to "bring humankind to believe in Jesus Christ, the true light of the world. The light of Christ will bring the world to a new hope and peace. The Church is to preach to the world that peace and life are only found in Jesus Christ the Son of God who comes to save humanity of sin and death.

The Church ... serves as a leaven and as a kind of soul for human society as it is to be renewed in Christ and transformed into God's family. ... the Church not only communicates divine life to men, but in some way casts the reflected light of that life over the entire earth.
