The Presentation of the Lord

The Feast of the Presentation of the Lord is an ancient celebration in the Church. It is also called Candlemas because, on this day, candles are blessed in many parishes. These candles remind us that Jesus is the Light of the World. The feast is celebrated on February 2, forty days after Christmas. It recalls the day when Mary and Joseph brought Jesus to the Temple in Jerusalem to present Him to God. This event is rooted in Jewish tradition. According to the Law of Moses, every firstborn son belonged to God. Jewish parents were to bring their son to the Temple and offer a small sacrifice in thanksgiving. By bringing Jesus to the Temple, Mary and Joseph followed God's law faithfully. This act shows their humility and obedience to God. The feast celebrates three main ideas. First, Jesus is recognized as the Light of the World, a light for all people. Second, it shows that Jesus came to fulfill the law, not to destroy it. He and His family obeyed the customs of their people. Third, it honors the deep faith of Mary and Joseph, who followed God's will at every step.

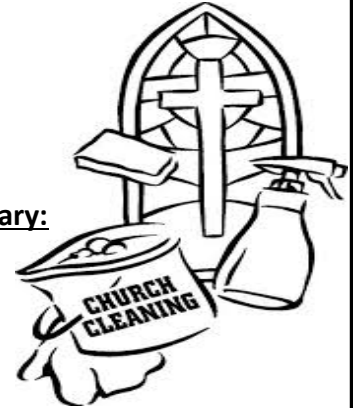

Día de la Candelaria

La Fiesta de la Candelaria o Día de la Candelaria se celebra el 2 de febrero de cada año. Es una fiesta de origen religioso en la que se elogia la imagen de la Virgen de la Candelaria, la Purificación de la Virgen y la Presentación de Jesús en el Templo. Origen de la fiesta:

En tiempo de Jesús, la ley prescribía en el Levítico que toda mujer debía presentarse en el templo para purificarse a los cuarenta días que hubiese dado a luz. Si el hijo nacido era varón, debía ser circuncidado a los ocho días y la madre debería permanecer en su casa durante treinta y tres días más, purificándose a través del recogimiento y la oración.

Ya que se cumpliera la fecha, acudía en compañía de su esposo a las puertas del templo para llevar una ofrenda: un cordero y una paloma o tórtola. Con respecto al niño, todo primogénito debía ser consagrado al Señor, en recuerdo de los primogénitos de Egipto que había salvado Dios. Lo mismo pasaba con los animales primogénitos.
