The Epiclesis

The epiclesis is the calling down of the Holy Spirit and takes place during the Liturgy of the Eucharist. The General Instruction for the Roman Missal, paragraph 79C states, "In the epicleses, the church implores the power of the Holy Spirit, that the gifts offered by human hands be consecrated, that is that they become Christ's body and blood, and that the unblemished sacrificial victim to be consumed in communion be for the salvation of those who partake in it."

People who hold on to Christ, like the Canaanite woman, realize they have nowhere else to turn. Their spirit is of God because they rely on God entirely. We often think the Christian life is about getting to heaven. But even more importantly, the Christian life is about making earth as it is in heaven. Don't we pray this in the Lord's Prayer: "Thy Will be done on earth as it is in Heaven." Just as in Heaven, the only thing that will matter to us is God. So, for us on earth, the only thing that matters if our Spirit is of God, is our faith in God.

When ideas come into our heads, it is good for us to test them. "Is this from God," we should ask. If it causes us to lessen our dependence on God, we should let it go.

In a moment, we will receive the body and blood of Christ. We come to communion knowing our dependence on Christ. Receiving Christ in the Eucharist, we know we are sustained. Receiving Christ in the Eucharist allows us to persevere in our Faith.
