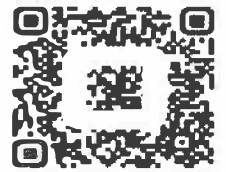

17th Sunday in ordinary time cycle A

Sunday's Gospel flies straight into the face of conventional wisdom: "The kingdom of heaven is like a merchant searching for fine pearls. When he finds a pearl of great price, he goes and sells all that he has and buys it." This pearl merchant first goes out "searching for fine pearls" in the plural — intending to find enough to make a pearl necklace, or bracelet, or at least a pair of earrings. He's looking for enough pearls to string, so that if one breaks or goes bad or missing or whatever, he's not lost his whole investment. But then this pearl merchant goes crazy — or at least, he gets very confident. "When he finds a pearl of great price, he goes and sells all that he has and buys it."

Now, generally, Jesus tells us parables to throw us off. Contrary to what a lot of people believe, parables are not little moral stories. For instance, nobody should think that not sharing your lamp-oil with other bridesmaids is the height of charity. Nobody should think that letting ninety-nine sheep on their own to go off and find one that got lost in the brambles is good farming practice. And nobody should think that investing all your assets in one big pearl is a financially sound decision. What Jesus is trying to do with the parables, instead, is to shake us up, to change how we imagine God, and how we imagine He will come and save us. God is unconditionally invested in each and everyone of us. He loves all his children. Each of one us is a pearl of infinite value to Him. God sent his only-begotten Son to lead a human life and lose that life for us. That is totally insane! It is not prudent; it doesn't even respect the basic natural law of all living beings — self-preservation. That's how crazy God's love is for each of us.

That is what Jesus, in the parables, is telling his disciples along the ages. And in return, what God hopes, what Christ hopes, what the Holy Spirit hopes, is that we will somehow reciprocate their love. They hope that divine love for each and every one of us will not remain unrequited. That we too will invest all we have on God, that we will "put all our chips" on His mercy and grace.
