

Saint of the Week

Francesca Bussa de' Leoni, known as Frances of Rome Obl.S.B., was an Italian Catholic mystic, organizer of charitable services and a Benedictine oblate who founded a religious community of oblates, who share a common life without religious vows. Frances' life combines aspects of secular and religious life. A devoted and loving wife, she longed for a lifestyle of prayer and service, so she organized a group of women to minister to the needs of Rome's poor. Born of wealthy parents, Saint Frances of Rome found herself attracted to the religious life during her youth. But her parents objected and a young nobleman was selected to be her husband. She was canonized in 1608.

Pope Leon XIV prayer intention for March:

For disarmament and peace:

Let us pray that nations move toward effective disarmament, particularly nuclear disarmament, and that world leaders choose the path of dialogue and diplomacy instead of violence.

Reflecion de Evangelio

.El Prefacio de la celebración eucarística de hoy nos hablará de que este diálogo termina con un trueque salvífico en donde el Señor, «(...) al pedir agua a la Samaritana, ya había infundido en ella la gracia de la fe, y si quiso estar sediento de la fe de aquella mujer, fue para encender en ella el fuego del amor divino».

Ese deseo salvador de Jesús vuelto “sed” es, hoy día también, “sed” de nuestra fe, de nuestra respuesta de fe ante tantas invitaciones cuaresmales a la conversión, al cambio, a reconciliarnos con Dios y los hermanos, a prepararnos lo mejor posible para recibir una nueva vida de resucitados en la Pascua que se nos acerca.

«Yo soy, el que te está hablando» (Jn 4,26): esta directa y manifiesta confesión de Jesús acerca de su misión, cosa que no había hecho con nadie antes, muestra igualmente el amor de Dios que se hace más búsqueda del pecador y promesa de salvación que saciará abundantemente el deseo humano de la Vida verdadera. Es así que, más adelante en este mismo Evangelio, Jesús proclamará: «Si alguno tiene sed, venga a mí, y beba el que crea en mí», como dice la Escritura: ‘De su seno correrán ríos de agua viva’» (Jn 7,37b-38). Por eso, tu compromiso es hoy salir de ti y decir a los hombres: «Venid a ver a un hombre que me ha dicho...» (Jn 4,29).

Third Week of Lent

March 8, 2026



Even Jesus begged for water. “Give me a drink” (John 4:7), he bids the Samaritan woman. She responds in disbelief. She has had to walk in the scorching, midday sun. How many times did she make that trip to and from the well while asking her own version of, “Are we there yet?” It’s been the same question she’s been asking for years to different men, different husbands. She has never quite found where “there” is. All she knows is that she must go to and from the well day in and day out. And yet now her deeper question is, “Could he possibly be the Christ?” (John 4:29). Is he finally here?

We’ve come to the third week of Lent and it feels like there is so much left to go. We are wandering. We are thirsting. We are asking. Will I finally keep my resolutions? Will I finally get to the “spiritual heights” I would like to get to? Will I ever be spiritually “there”?

In the “not yet” of our wandering, he answers and says, “I walk with you in the desert.” “I seek you in the noonday heat.” “I am with you” (Matthew 28:20). He will bring water. He will bring more than enough to quench our thirst. On Calvary, his side will be opened, and on Easter, he will wash us with this water! Still he will give even more. He will feed us with bread and wine — his Body and Blood.

Then we will “know that this is truly the savior of the world” (John 4:42) and he is here.
