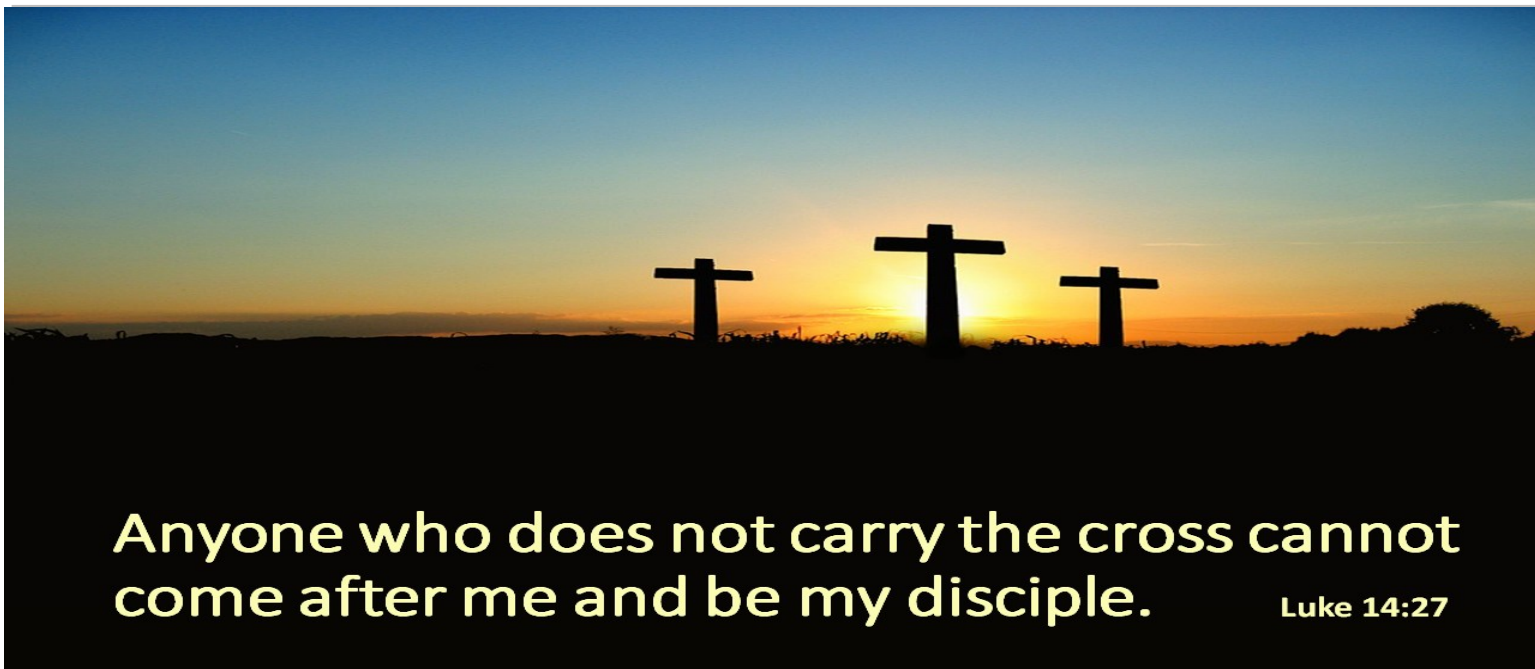

**SAN PEDRO Y SAN PABLO Solemnidad de San Pedro y San Pablo, apóstoles. Simón, hijo de Jonás y hermano de Andrés, fue el primero entre los discípulos que confesó a Cristo como Hijo de Dios vivo, y por ello fue llamado Pedro. Pablo, apóstol de los gentiles, predicó a Cristo crucificado a judíos y griegos. Los dos, con la fuerza de la fe y el amor a Jesucristo, anunciaron el evangelio en la ciudad de Roma, donde, en tiempo del emperador Nerón, ambos sufrieron el martirio: Pedro, como narra la tradición, crucificado cabeza abajo y sepultado en el Vaticano, cerca de la vía Triunfal, y Pablo, degollado y enterrado en la vía Ostiense. En este día, su triunfo es celebrado por todo el mundo con honor y veneración.**

**Jesús I a experiencia de la cruz**

La predicación del Evangelio que Jesús encomienda a sus discípulos estará marcada por la experiencia de la cruz, pero al mismo tiempo augura una gran recompensa a quienes la acogen.

El texto de la primera lectura es una manifestación concreta de la fecundidad que brota del encuentro con Dios. La vida de la mujer sunamita era buena, pero carecía de descendencia. Ello en el contexto bíblico es una imagen de una vida incompleta. Pero su hospitalidad le significó un cambio inesperado: «tendrás un hijo en tus brazos». Así Dios recompensa a quienes han recibido a un profeta.

«La palabra de Dios, cuando encuentra hospitalidad, no solo instruye, sino que engendra vida» (Von Balthasar).

La gran recompensa que tendrán aquellos que reciben a los discípulos de Cristo es el mismo Cristo. «El que los recibe a ustedes, me recibe a mí; y el que me recibe, recibe a Aquél que me envió».

**13th Sunday in ordinary time cycle A**

Today, the Gospel confronts us with a decisive truth: Christ does not want to occupy just a place in our lives; He wants to be the center of our lives. That is why He says: “Whoever loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me” (Mt 10:37). Jesus did not come to become one interest among many others, nor to be an occasional reference point in certain moments of life.

The true disciple does not fit Christ into his life; he builds his life around Christ. Elsewhere, Jesus adds: “What profit would there be for one to gain the whole world and forfeit his life?” (Mt 16:26).

The cross that every disciple must take up (cf. Mt 10:38) represents Christ’s own path. Carrying the cross does not mean seeking suffering, but remaining faithful to the Lord when living the Gospel comes at a cost. Whoever follows Christ is already walking the road that leads to the Resurrection. In this way, Jesus teaches us that authentic love has a proper order: it is not a matter of loving our family less, but of loving everyone from God and in God. Saint Augustine of Hippo said, “Love, and do what you will.” When God holds first place, everything else finds its proper balance. Moreover, Christ does not command us to abandon those we love, but to choose God’s truth whenever human affections try to draw us away from it.

The Lord concludes with a promise: “Whoever gives even a cup of cold water to one of these little ones will surely not lose his reward” (Mt 10:42). Nothing we do for Christ will be forgotten. At the final judgment, what will matter is not who accumulated the most possessions, but who loved the most. For this reason, the teaching of Pope Leo XIV at the beginning of his pontificate resonates powerfully: “This is the hour for love! The heart of the Gospel is the love of God that makes us brothers and sisters.” May the Lord grant us a free and generous heart, so that we may love Him above all things. Amen.
