

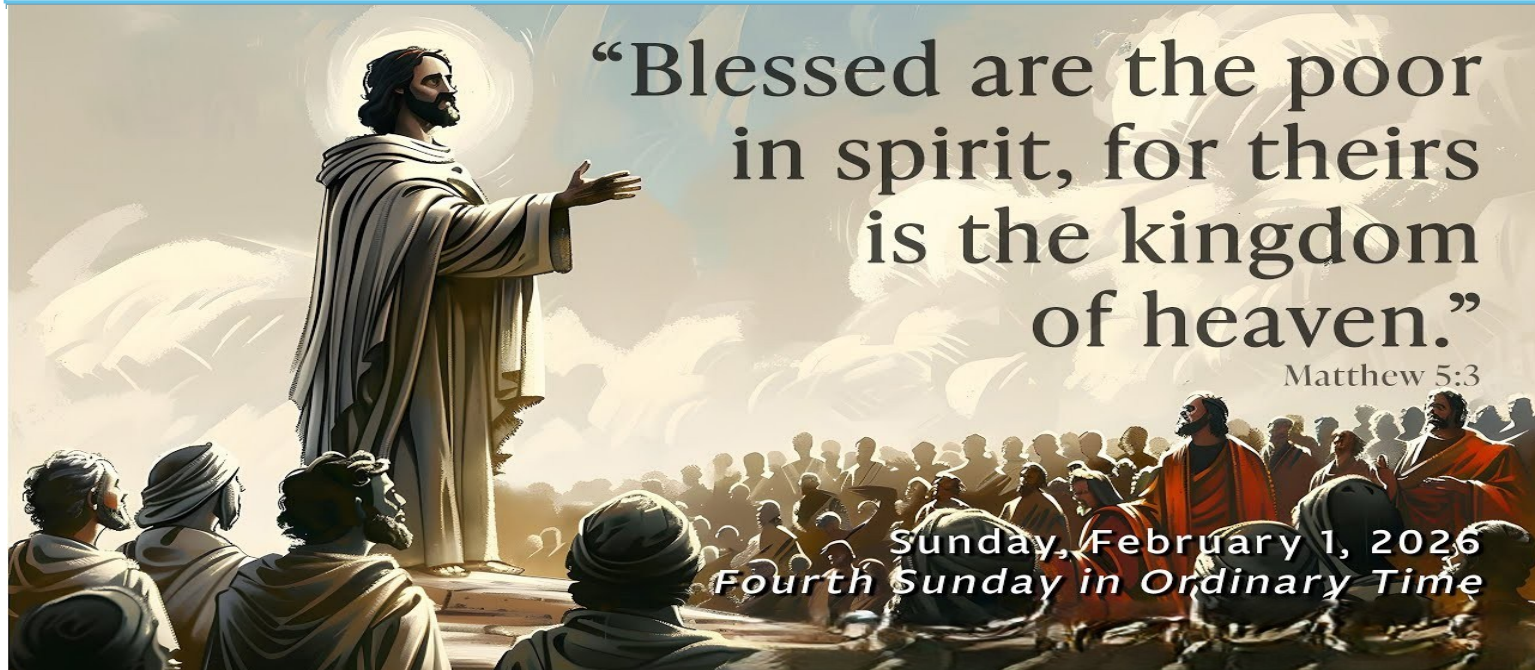

Saint of the Week

Saint Blaise martyred 316 AD

After his death, he was made a saint and has become the patron saint of wool combers, wild animals, candle makers and ailments of the throat. Saint Blaise was a popular saint in medieval England, probably due to the connection with wool combing and the wool trade, which was an important industry at the time. While in hiding during his persecution, Blaise is said to have healed sick and wounded animals. He also saved a boy with a fishbone stuck in his throat. Let us pray that children suffering from incurable diseases and their families receive the necessary medical care and support, never losing strength and hope.



Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time – February 1

Today's readings and the Gospel and the beatitudes teach us that belonging to Christ looks very different than belonging to the world. Where the world values the rich, the powerful, the strong, Jesus values the poor, the humble, the weak. The beatitudes are meant to comfort us, not scare us, because they promise us that, if we follow Christ and are shunned by world, we need not worry because our ultimate happiness does not lie in this world, but in the kingdom to come. And our suffering will be rewarded. The beatitudes are meant to encourage us to reject the world and embrace Christ, to have the strength to stand out and stand up for the True, the Good, and the Beautiful, and not simply whatever is fashionable.

Cuarto Domingo del tiempo Ordinario—Febrero 1
