### Saint of the Week Saint Katherine Drexel, (1858–1955)

Born into the wealthy Drexel banking family, she inherited a share of a \$15.5 million estate. Katharine was remembered for her love of the Eucharist and a desire for unity of all peoples. She was courageous and took the initiative to address social inequality within minorities. She believed all should have access to a quality education and her selfless service, including the donation of her inheritance, helped many reach that goal. St. Katharine was beatified on November 20, 1988 and canonized on October 1, 2000 by Pope John Paul II. Relics of St. Katharine can be found at St. Raphael the Archangel Catholic Church in Raleigh, North Carolina, and in the Day Chapel of Saint Katharine Drexel Parish in Sugar Grove, Illinois.

### Pope Leon XIV prayer intention for March:

For disarmament and peace:

Let us pray that nations move toward effective disarmament, particularly nuclear disarmament, and that world leaders choose the path of dialogue and diplomacy instead of violence.

### Reflecion de Evangelio

Este hecho es importante, porque la liturgia nos quiere mostrar que la Transfiguración es un hito relevante en el camino cuaresmal. Ha sido una opción litúrgica desde el tiempo de los santos padres, que desean que no perdamos de vista el objetivo de la Cuaresma, que es la Pascua. Se podría decir que el misterio de la transfiguración es un recurso pedagógico para fortalecer la fe de los discípulos y la nuestra ante el escándalo de la cruz. Y lo hace mostrando el revés de la Cruz: la Gloria.

San León Magno dice: «El Señor descubrió a sus discípulos la gloria de su divinidad, para que no se escandalizaran de la humildad de su cruz». En nuestro camino cuaresmal también puede significar que el itinerario ascético propio de este tiempo nos llevará a una plenitud de vida. El ayuno, la lucha contra la tentación, la oración más intensa, la conversión del corazón, bien valen la pena. Vale la pena corregir la vida, pues, aunque implique una cierta mortificación, ella nos llevará a una plenitud de vida verdadera.

## Second Week of Lent

March 1, 2026



The disciples and Apostles must have been frightened and discouraged after Jesus's prophecy of His death in Matthew 16:21-23. To give them a vision to grasp in their darkest hour when they would witness the fulfillment of the prediction of His death, Jesus took three Apostles, Peter, James, and John, up a "high mountain" where He allowed them to witness a manifestation of His glory. What they saw confirmed that Jesus is the Son of God and has the power to come in glory after what He has told them takes place. These three Apostles would also be separated from the others when Jesus faced His agony in the Garden of Gethsemane.

At the great divine revelation before him, Peter once again responds boldly if not all too eagerly: "Let us build tents." When the voice speaks from the bright cloud, all three — Peter, James and John — fall on their faces, for they "were very much afraid" (Matthew 17:6). Would they be struck? Would they be destroyed? Surely, they had heard of the man who touched the Ark and was struck down (Cf., 2 Samuel 6:6-11). Would they be next? They fold all at once.

"But Jesus came and touched them" (Matthew 17:7). The human and divine touch doesn't destroy. It soothes. It heals. It frees, for it belongs to the one "who destroyed death and brought life" (2 Timothy 1:10) and in whom we can place our trust (cf., Psalm 33:22). The shame of sin makes us fold. This Lent, the touch of Christ bids us: "Rise!" Rise from sin, and "do not be afraid" (Matthew 17:7).

The story of the Transfiguration provides hope for all professing Christians. It is the vision that all of us who accept Jesus's call to discipleship hope to witness.
